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Proposed Reopening Plan

The collective community of the I/DD care delivery system is living and working through an unprecedented COVID-19 public health emergency. As Governor

Cuomo begins to lift restrictions and reopens New York State, service providers, Fiscal Intermediaries (FIs), Care Coordination Organizations/Health Homes (CCOs/HHs), and individuals and families must begin planning a safe reopening of the OPWDD service delivery system.

Through the bi-weekly COVID-19 online meetings that Care Design NY has hosted for the past eight weeks and in numerous conversations with key stakeholders, we have drafted a guidance document for the reopening of the OPWDD service system. A key component to the reopening plan requires answering this question: **"How do we take the best practices in service delivery that we are learning as a result of this public health emergency and incorporate those practices into models that will best meet people's needs in the 'new normal' post COVID-19"?**

Our proposed guidance document is informed by data and experiences reported by service providers, CCOs, advocates, individuals and families during the COVID-19 pandemic. The #1 guiding principle in the reopening plan has been-- lives depend upon a thorough assessment of risk factors and careful examination of components that will align with the State's regional reopening. Collaboration across the OPWDD service delivery area and in the catchment areas that providers, FIs, and CCOs/HHs operate will ensure a cohesive and consistent guidance document to reopen services for the individuals and families we support.

Areas of focus in this person-centered guidance document include infection control and prevention, training for the service delivery workforce, individuals, and families, transportation, personal protective equipment (PPE), community engagement, site based day services, testing/contact tracing, and financial continuity planning.
