FDA Recalls Hand Sanitizers

The Food and Drug Administration (FDA) has issued a warning to consumers that some hand sanitizer products may contain methanol, also referred to as wood alcohol. Methanol can be dangerous when absorbed through the skin or swallowed. The FDA stated that anyone who has been exposed to a hand sanitizer containing methanol should seek immediate treatment.
