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## **Special Education Family Online Session Tuesday, August 18: 12:30 pm OR 7:00 pm EDT**

Whether you are an educator, a provider of related services, a student with a disability (SWD), or a family member supporting a SWD, you likely struggled with the challenges of online/remote learning following the school closures in March because of the COVID-19 public health crisis. Extended school year (ESY) programming will soon come to an end. These are just a few of the questions families have been asking:

2. If school districts return to online programming in the fall, what would improve your child's learning experience?
