### 2020 Flu Season: Importance of a flu vaccine

It is especially critical this year that we prepare and do everything possible to prevent the flu. Health experts are warning of a "twindemic," as COVID-19 cases continue to rise and with the flu season looming.

OPWDD Commissioner Kastner, released a statement on the importance of getting a flu vaccine this season. <u>Click here</u> to read. A flu vaccination is especially important for people with neurologic conditions like intellectual disability and cerebral palsy who are more prone to hospitalization and even death as a result of the illness. A vaccine can keep people from getting sick, reduce the severity of the illness if they should contract the flu virus, and reduce the risk of a flu-associated hospitalization.
