Protect I/DD Community in COVID-19 Second Wave

Protect People with Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities (I/DD) from COVID: Prioritize Prevention to Reduce Infections & Deaths

Today, 11.18.20, the Family Advisory Board contacted Governor Cuomo,

OPWDD Commissioner Kastner, and DOH Commissioner Zucker with their concerns and the following:

- The State follow established public health practices and not permit potentially infected staff to continue working; endangering the health and safety of individuals with I/DD in their care.
- 2. Staff in congregate care settings be tested weekly for COVID-19, as is required in nursing homes in New York State.
- 3. Individuals with I/DD be included as a priority group for the COVID-19 vaccine distribution.

This HCBS Waiver is the Medicaid program that provides opportunities for adults and children with intellectual and/or developmental disabilities (I/DD) to receive services in their own home or community.
